#### 3rd Class: Starting the Relationship

Who Can Accept Christ?  
John 3:16 "whoever"  
Choosing your own horse - would you take just any? Christ receives All.  
Christ Asking you to receive him.  
Revelation 3:20 knocking and hearing his voice  
Cue horse to get horse to receive you as master/owner/trainer.  
Receiving Christ.  
Mouth and Heart - Romans 10:9.  
Horses cannot save - Psalm 33:17.  
Beginning of the relationship.  
Begin relationship with horse by being close.  
Starting to learn about Christ.  
Learn His word - Psalm 119:105.  
Bit is one way horse learns your desires - James 3:3.  
Prayer is talking to God.  
Psalm 32:6.  
Pray without ceasing.  
Talk to horse (NOT Horse whispering) in soothing tones/harsh tones/angry tones.  
Sunday School & Church.  
Learn to be still and know God.  
Learn His word.  
Fellowship with believers.  
Trailer Loading like going to church.  
Learn to Stand Still.  
Learn to receive reward like eating.  
Learn to be in another environment.
